SEA provides e-Learning for Type 45 Flight Deck Controllers

SEA is pleased to announce a recent contract award to provide the Ministry of Defence Maritime Trainers IPT with a training system for Royal Navy (RN) Flight Deck Officers and Type 45 Destroyer Flight Deck Controllers.

The system will provide an immersive simulation environment for students of both ashore and afloat aircraft marshalling, including models for all major RN ship types and a wide variety of helicopters. It will give the RN School of Flight Deck Operations a new level of training capability, enabling it to prepare qualified deck personnel for the operational launch of this major new RN vessel.

Commenting on the contract award, Paul Phillips, SEA's Defence Division Managing Director said: "SEA is already providing e-Learning media for use by the HMS COLLINGWOOD-based Type 45 Training Unit in their courses for on-board maintainers. This contract represents a new and significant element in our provision of innovative training solutions to the RN."
