



SEA awarded two contracts by Network Rail

SEA Group is pleased to announce the award of two contracts by Network Rail (circa £2M). The first contract is to deliver the Signallers Forms Automation Project. The project is designed to automate a manual paper-based system of forms to an electronic version. The project will enable Network Rail to utilise a more effective means of capturing, storing and disseminating forms related information between Signallers and other Operational third parties. The solution is to be implemented in Integrated Electronics Control Centres (IECCs) and Power Signal boxes, as well as some large manual boxes.

The second contract is for Signal Sighting Asset Data Store (SSADS). SSADS will be used to manage signal asset condition assessments and work planning of signalling renewals. The project will support consistent decision making/planning (justification) for signalling renewals by providing a single source of information about planned work and assets. The SSADS solution will provide a central operational repository for signalling asset data.

Jon Hargroves, General Manager of SEA's Transport Division commented: "The award of these projects is an exciting development in our business relationship with Network Rail and demonstrates the faith in SEA's ability to successfully deliver projects for this most prestigious client at the heart of the UK railway system. "
